IN 2020, NEW YORK LIFE RESPONDED TO THE UNEXPECTED

When COVID-19 hit, New York Life and our Foundation provided emergency pandemic relief grants to support communities across the country. We created the Brave of Heart Fund with the Cigna Foundation to support the families of healthcare workers who died of COVID-19. We supported disaster relief organizations in communities devastated by wildfires and other natural disasters. And in response to the social justice movement we donated **\$1 million** to the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund, along with additional grants to several key social justice organizations.
