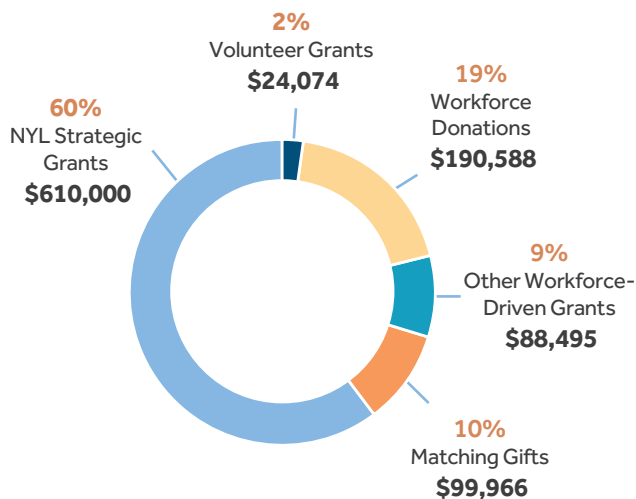

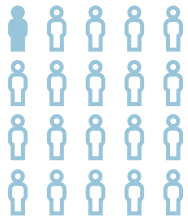
## Childhood Bereavement
